Just sit very still and keep your eyes

COLIN

HENRY

COLIN

HENRY

Ask your mother.

CUT TO:

END

HENRY

That's enough. We get it. Your brother is an idiot. (YELLING) Colin!

COLIN (O.C.)

What?!

HENRY

Come in here! We want to talk to you about getting a paintball gun!

COLIN (12), A LITTLE SMART-ASS, RUNS INTO THE ROOM.

COLIN

Really?

HENRY

No. I lied.

Colin, don't lie to

your sister.

INRV

COLIN

Get me a paintball gun and I'll stop.

SARAH

No, you'll stop now.

HENRY

Great, problem solved. Now everybody get out. I have a wine party tomorrow.

TOTE



HENRY FLICKS ON THE LIGHT TO REVEAL A GHOSTLY WOMAN, HIS SISTER JANET (28), AN OVER-EDUCATED, UNDEREMPLOYED DREAMER.

ZOIE

Ghost! Close your mouth!

SARAH

It's just Aunt Janet.

JANET

I think I'm a lesbian.

COLIN

What's a lesbian?

OFF HENRY'S PERTURBED FACE WE ...

CUT TO:

INT. STAIRS/KITCHEN - MOMENTS LATER (DAY 1)

HENRY AND SARAH FOLLOW JANET DOWN THE STAIRS INTO THE KITCHEN.

END

HENRY

Janet, we love having you live here and we support all your choices, but before you tell our children about being a lesbian--SARAH
