EXT./EST. THE ROXY - NIGHT

The marquee tells us that The Pussycat Dolls are indeed performing two shows a night as we HEAR their signature encore, "Don't Cha Wish Your Girlfriend Was Hot Like Me."

CUT TO:

INT. ROXY/BACKSTAGE - NIGHT

MATT is watching THE PUSSYCAT DOLLS perform their encore from the wings. The DOLLS are wearing thigh-high leather stiletto boots.

THE PUSSYCAT DOLLS

(singing)

DON'T CHA WISH YOUR GIRLFRIEND WAS A
FREAK LIKE ME?
DON'T CHA, DON'T CHA
DON'T CHA WISH YOUR GIRLFRIEND WAS RAW
LIKE ME?
DON'T CHA WISH YOUR GIRLFRIEND WAS FUN
LIKE ME?

They end the number to wild cheers as they bow, wave and come offstage.

They all know MATT--

DOLL #1
Matt!

DOLL #2
Matty!

MATT
Hey. Guys. That was great.
(calling)
Wendy.

WENDY
I see you.

MATT
I just need you for a second and I'll be outa your way.

WENDY
I never wanted you outa my way, remember?

MATT

I do.

WENDY

What do you need?

MATT

I need a favor.

WENDY

The first two shows have been great. Funny. Really smart. You and Danny are the talk of the town and I'm really proud of you.

MATT

WENDY

MATT

I'd like one of your boots.

WENDY

My boots.

MATT

That you're wearing right now. And I need you to sign the inside of it, "Call me, pussycat" with the comma after "me" and then I need you to add your measurements.

WENDY

Sure.

WENDY sits and begins taking her boot off--

MATT

You don't want to know why?

WENDY

I just did two shows, Matt, you really want a therapy session right now?

MATT

Here, you can use this pen.

WENDY'S pulled her boot off--
